#### Lessons learned from DA

- Policy for rebates on people contributing labour to the event.
  - SCANZ rules on concessions.
  - Diego: people working for the entire event can be compensated.
  - Ildhafn: if the event makes a surplus, people can be compensated.
  - Bernard: did this many years ago, built it into the budget. Used to comp the main feast cook.
  - Agate: requesting the feast cooking crew not have to pay for the feast (\$25).
- More detail needed on booking.
- Bunk room assignments.
- Event cost ~\$5,350, implications for bank balance
  - If we want to spend, we need to fund raise.
- Is Brookfield the right venue for us still?
  - Winter event
  - Ageing membership
  - Alternate venues for Crown events

**ACTION:** Agate to send list of feast assistants to Miles and Diego, we can comp them for the feast.

**ACTION:** Shire website needs a policy section to capture major financial rules like this.

**ACTION:** Need a policy to guide decisions for future events. Note, compensation for staff needs to be built into the event budget.

**ACTION:** get linen commercially laundered. Note another item to be included in future budgets.
