Officers Reports

Constable: Pottery cup from CF, being half blue slip half white, a small pewter tankard. Bring lost and found to A&S next week to photograph so they can go up on the website.

Reeve: Account balance, \$2195.55, income \$99 from March camp, income \$15.74 in interest, closing balance \$2274.29. Includes \$12 for Kingdom and \$14 for SCANZ Inc.

Lists: Decided not to apply for Kingdom Lists, a new person has been appointed – not me (Sharon).

Darton Champion Tourney (Martin to email Sharon lists) Results: 1 st Asbjorn, 2 nd Ulf, 3 rd William, 4 th Bearnard.

Chronicler. Produced a Clarion last month. Need more articles. Advertising a replacement in next issue of the Clarion and on the list. No response to emails sent to list regarding council members contact details, and position timeframes.

Marshal: Nothing to Report. Stepping down soon, notice to be sent to Robyn G. for the Clarion. Two people volunteer.

Arts and Sciences: (Robyn N. not present) Dance workshops are planned before Coronation. (Sharon cannot help till after her trip to Japan).

Seneschal: Interim ruling from Kingdom Seneschal with regards to Steel weapons been used at events. Background, some people wanting to do steel fighting at SCA events. Suggested that it come under the auspices of the Arts and Sciences office. Conducted in a "non-competitive" teaching-learning environment. Therefore creating an office of Deputy Arts and Sciences officer in charge of Steel. Maggie has asked Kerry.

Nothing has been done about the Darton Champion Rapier Tourneys.

Buying kitchen stuff - planned for Sunday afternoon. For the list see last meetings minutes, plan is to meet at the Forests at 1 pm.

Banners – Dama as a source of silk and silk paints. How do we want to pay and how much? AG brought 30 or 100 yards as well as paints/dyes. Darton investigations continue by Richard. Maggie to check with Ildhafn to see of they want to join in on a bolt of silk and standard heraldic colours.

Family membership \$20 is available to an adult living at the same address as a subscribing member. It is a membership without an individual subscription to Pegasus. It counts as a subscribing membership as you'd have access to the Pegasus from the other member.

Associate membership \$22. Which is an independent subscription-free membership. You receive the administrative issue of Pegasus (with the kingdom laws) but no other Pegasus. It does not entitle you to hold kingdom office or fight crown, as you have to be a subscribing member for those, i.e. have access to Pegasus.
